Essay Question Rubric

Alumni Scholarship essay questions will be graded by the following rubric:

- 1. Clear topic and concise delivery: Obvious effort identifying a specific topic and keeping contents focused and concise. (3 points)
- 2. Writing: Very few, if any spelling or grammatical errors. (3 points)
- 3. Unique Insights: Writer communicated unique point-of-view and insights to each essay question. (2 points)
- 4. Formatting: Does not exceed 1 page, Calibri 11pt font, 1.15 line spacing, three to four sentences minimum per question. (2 points)
