## Texas Wesleyan University Alumni Association Scholarship Application Requirements

The Alumni Association Scholarship Program was established to award financial assistance to relatives of alumni to encourage them to complete their undergraduate degree at Texas Wesleyan. Recipients shall be decided upon by a scholarship committee comprised of members of the Alumni Association Board of Directors.

Alumni Association Scholarship awards are funded for undergraduate students by the Alumni Endowed Scholarship Fund, the Earl and Esther Hiers Endowed Scholarship Fund and the Glen D. Tuggle Alumni Scholarship Fund. All past recipients are required to reapply each year, in order to be reconsidered.

Alumni Scholarship essay questions will be graded by the following rubric:
<ol> <li>Clear topic and concise delivery: Obvious effort identifying a specific topic and keeping contents focused and concise. (3 points)</li> <li>Writing: Very few, if any spelling or grammatical errors. (3 points)</li> <li>Unique Insights: Writer communicated unique point-of-view and insights to each essay question. (2 points)</li> <li>Formatting: Does not exceed 1 page, Calibri 11pt font, 1.15 line spacing, three to four sentences minimum per question. (2 points)</li> </ol>
